SPARKLING WINE

Conde de Subirats Cava Brut, Spain – Fresh citrus acidity, green meadow aromas & orchard peach flavors. **12/38**

Chandon Blanc de Noir, Napa Valley – Dark cherry, strawberries, dark berries. **12/38**

Mumm Napa Brut Prestige, Napa Valley – California sparkling wine *using Méthode traditionnelle (like French Champagne)*. Toasted brioche, baked pear & lemon zest. **13/41**

Chandon Rosé, Napa Valley – *Méthode traditionnelle*. Ripe strawberries & stone fruits, creamy on the palate. Deep pink. Well defined structure & pairs well with food. **14/ -**

WHITES

2008 Ventana Sauvignon Blanc, Arroyo Seco – *Sustainable* winner of 4 Silver Medals. Honey, white peach, honeysuckle with acacia blossom minerality. Refreshing, silky & smooth. **9/29**

2007 Chateau de la Roche Touraine Sauvignon Blanc, Loire, France – Sustainable agriculture. Honey, citrus, green grass & ripe fruit aromas. Subtle palate with distinctive smoky finish. **13/41**

2005 Edmunds St. John Witters Vineyard Pinot Grigio, El Dorado County – Sierra-Nevada foothills high elevation offers cool nights & volcanic soil. No oakiness – entirely stainless steel barrels for pleasing freshness. **11/34**

2007 Estancia Chardonnay, Monterey County – Tropical & stone fruits marry citrus & toasty oak. **10/32**

2007 Bonterra Vineyards Chardonnay, Mendocino County – *Organic*. Pear, apple & lemon zest balance creamy vanilla richness. **11/35**

2004 Dierberg Chardonnay, Santa Maria Valley – Elegant white peach, lemon grass, celery root & peach jam. Coriander & nutmeg spice. Distinct minerality. Toasted hazelnuts, buttery vanilla, creamy lemon curd. Exceptionally long finish. - **/68**

2006 Clos de Nouys Vouvray Demi Sec, France – Rose & acacia minerality with delicate sweet-savory flavors of green almond & Picholine olive followed by an apricot brandy finish. **15/47**

2008 Ca' del Solo Estate Vineyard Muscat, Monterey County – Papaya & lychee aromas. Grapefruit & wildflower honey. Good concentration, smooth acidity. White peach & minerality. **13/41**

2007 Bridlewood Viognier, Central Coast – Dense, attractive apricot jam aromas. Lily-of-the-valley & violets. Big mouthful of fruit with balancing acidity. **13/41**

REDS

2005 Pacific Oasis Pinot Noir, Santa Barbara County – Aromas of black cherry, brambles & red fruits. Smooth silk mouth-feel & fruit-rich flavor. **11/35**

2007 Bliss Family Vineyards Pinot Noir, Mendocino North Coast – Strawberry jam & black raspberry opening to hints of cedar, bay, nutmeg & allspice. Good mouth-feel, refreshing & long. **13/41**

2006 Tolosa Estate Vineyards Edna Ranch Pinot Noir, Edna Valley – Sustainable & estate-bottled. Cherries & red currants with sweet-smokiness. Silky & dry. **13/41**

2006 Creta Roble Tempranillo, Ribera del Duero, Spain – 70-year old vines & oak barrels contribute to aromas of blackberry, cedar, black currant followed by distinct high-elevation minerality. **14/45**

2004 Bonny Doon Vineyard Le Cigare Volant, Santa Cruz County – Châteauneuf-du-Pape-esque dark & vibrant flagship wine. Rose petals, black licorice, black cherry, pepper. **14/45**

2007 Bogle Vineyards Old Vine Zinfandel, California – Selected grapes from high-flavor-low-yield early 1900's vineyards. Richly concentrated flavors of bramble, black cherry, framboise with vanilla tones. **12/38**

2008 Terra Robles Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles – Intense cherry flavors with balanced cranberry tannins. **12/38**

2007 Michael Pozzan Knights Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley – Family winery with three generations of winemaking heritage. Aromas of damask rose, black cherry, brambles. Fruit forward flavors lightly spiced. **14/45**
